Reach, in partnership with Rainbow Place Shelter, has been invited by the City of Rockville to host one of three Rockville Mayor and Council Candidate forums. The forum will take place on October 5th at 7pm at F. Scott Fitzgerald Theater, 603 Edmonston Drive in Rockville.

Before casting votes on Tuesday, November 7, City of Rockville residents should take advantage of this chance to hear from the two candidates for Mayor and twelve Council candidates who are vying to fill six seats. The City

election will also offer residents the opportunity to respond to four questions about who can vote and the requirements of representatives. Rockville residents and others are encouraged to attend the forums in person.

Celebrating Agnes Saenz



After 32 years with Reach and the Kaseman Health Clinic, Executive Director Agnes Saenz stepped down on September 8th. Several events took place to celebrate her dedication and efforts.

Agnes was honored by the Rockville Mayor and Council with a certificate of recognition. It reads, "The City of Rockville, Maryland, is honored to congratulate and celebrate your amazing 32 years of dedicated work for the City of Rockville and the Montgomery County community. You have been a tireless and effective advocate for the most vulnerable members of Montgomery County. You enriched the lives of so many, and your good works, kindness and compassion have enhanced our community!"

Reach hosted a farewell event for Agnes on September 13th. Representatives of both County Executive Marc Elrich and Montgomery County Councilmember Laurie-Anne Sayles presented Agnes with proclamations recognizing her achievements.

Attendees included current and former staff, board members, pastors, long-term supporters, and family. Paul Love, Reach Board Chair, and Donna Perry, Clinic Board Chair, both gave remarks, as did Kasey Kaseman, former Executive Director of Reach who hired Agnes in 1991. Kasey summarized the overall feeling of the evening in saying:

"Recognizing all that you've contributed to the lives of all of us gathered here and to the lives of tens of thousands in the programs of Community Reach of Montgomery County and this Clinic, there's neither time nor would I have the ability to provide an adequate accounting of all the great and quiet achievements that you've given us. The best I can do on behalf of us all is to say thank you."

LOP Turns 30 and Returns to Some In-Person Classes



The Language Outreach Program is celebrating its 30th anniversary this month. Since its inception in September 1993, LOP has grown to become a trusted partner and knowledge provider in the local community. Our non-profit and municipal partners recognize the strength of LOP's work. When residents requested English classes at Rockville community centers, city staff partnered with LOP to provide hybrid conversation classes at two locations.

This year, we're continuing our collaboration with the City of Rockville to offer fully in-person ESL classes at those community centers. Classes are available at Twinbrook (pictured above) and Lincoln Park. Each location also provides child care and child tutoring while parents are learning English. In developing their language skills, these students are starting their journey to becoming more integrated in their new homes. 
