MKHC to Host Vaccine Day in Conjunction with Montgomery County DHHS



The Mansfield Kaseman Health Clinic will host a COVID & Flu Vaccination Day on December 22nd from 10am-3pm at 8 West Middle Lane, Rockville, MD.

The event, held in conjunction with Montgomery County DHHS, will offer two vaccines: The COVID-19 Comirnaty (Pfizer) vaccine, which is free for individuals 19+ without insurance or whose insurance doesn't cover the vaccine, and the flu vaccine, free and available to all 6 months or older.

We are pleased to partner with the County to help make vaccines more accessible, especially for the medically underserved. In particular, we hope to encourage patients who may be hesitant about interacting with authorities or getting medical care at unfamiliar places, or who don't know how to find free vaccines, to comfortably access vaccinations.


